A research artist, curator, and essayist, she holds a Master of Fine Arts from Tisch School of the Arts, New York University. She is an affiliated research artist at the Polytechnic Institute of Tomar (Portugal) in the field of TechArt.

She is the founder and director of Mémoire de l'Avenir (2003) and Humanities, Arts & Society – HAS (2016), platforms that bring together artists, researchers, and project leaders worldwide. These initiatives collaborate with UNESCO–MOST, the International Council for Philosophy and Human Sciences (CIPSH), the Académie de Paris, the Île-de-France Region, DRAC, the City of Paris, Jerusalem-based institutions, DILCRAH, the Fondation pour la Mémoire de la Shoah, and others.

Her work has been presented internationally in over 88 group exhibitions and 30 solo exhibitions. She is co-editor of HAS Magazine with Luiz Oosterbeek and has organized multidisciplinary exhibitions, conferences, and public programs across Europe, the United States, Africa, Asia, and the Middle East, promoting cultural diversity and intercultural dialogue through the arts.

She has participated in international forums including the WAAS Conference on Human Security, The Jena Declaration, Apheleia Conferences on Cultural Landscape Management (Macau/Portugal), and the World Humanities Conferences. She was co-coordinator of the Erasmus AMIGO Program (Portugal–Israel–Palestine) between the Polytechnic Institute of Tomar and Tel Aviv University. Her projects have received official recognition from the Institut Français, the Franco-Portuguese Season, World Logic Day (WLD), and European Humanities initiatives.

She is the author of numerous essays and, with Patricia Créveaux, co-author of *From Drawing to Symbol: A Grammar for Humanity* (Alternative, 2010). She has also collaborated with institutions including the Musée du Quai Branly, Centre Pompidou, Musée du Louvre, Musée d'Art et d'Histoire du Judaïsme, Institut du Monde Arabe, Musée de l'Homme, and others.

Received several distinctions, including the City of Paris Medal (2019–2020), as well as cultural and social cohesion awards such as the Minister of Culture's Labels, the National Agency for Social Cohesion and Equal Opportunities (Acsé), and the European Commission for Intercultural Dialogue (2009).

Has been an active member of the Fusion Arts movement and the R.S., a collective of East Village artists from 1980 to 1988.

Arts and artists bridge the gaps between people, continents, cultures, civilizations, and time.

STATEMENT

As a research artist, I have always been inspired by artists and thinkers engaged in multidisciplinary reflection on fundamental ethical, social, and human questions. This commitment led me to found Mémoire de l'Avenir, and later, together with UNESCO-MOST and CIPSH, to create the Humanities, Arts & Society (HAS) project.

HAS is a collective of artists, project leaders, and scholars from all regions of the world, transcending geographic, cultural, and personal differences. Its aim is to deepen our understanding of realities, limits, cultural references, symbols, languages, ethics, and aesthetics.

All human actions are grounded in cultural, social, and ethical constructions of knowledge, interpretation, engagement, and awareness. The arts—working in dialogue with all fields of science—are essential to enhancing creativity and imagining new futures, connecting global challenges with emerging local responses.

Our goal is not merely to echo existing concepts or reproduce artistic projects addressing urgent issues—inequality, conflict, migration, biodiversity loss, climate change—but to contribute to new forms of resilience, rooted in the humanities and the arts.

Artists build bridges across people, continents, cultures, civilizations, and time. The arts mirror the entire journey of humanity: an ongoing inquiry into the nature of beings and of the world—questioning, thinking, proposing, and producing. From nature to culture, nowhere on earth do humans exist without language, art, or culture.

Sharing knowledge deepens our understanding of ourselves and the world, and calls upon each of us to act and to participate. Artists offer new ways to discover, to influence, to provoke, to propose, and to perform.
